


Raising funds for:-



Invitation to support Charlies Trophy Friday August 2nd 2019

I am writing to ask you to support a special charity golf day to be held at Dainton Park Golf Club, Ipplepen, Newton Abbot, Devon, TQ12 5TN.

Last year was the sixth 'Charlie's Trophy' golf day with 132 golfers supporting the event, it proved to be a great success with £17,250 being raised. Over £84,000 has been distributed to more than 15 different charities through the generosity of the golf day supporters.

This year our charities are: -

British Heart Foundation, RTS Support Group, Cystic Fibrosis Comfort Fund, CATCH Project Citizens Advice Teignbridge, Torbay Holidays Helpers Network & RC of Newton Abbot.

The golf day is named after my grandson Charlie Lawlor, who has a condition called Rubinstein-Taybi Syndrome [RTS]. Charlie's parents, my daughter Becky and son-in-law Gary are very keen to raise awareness of RTS.



Last Autumn we were shocked by the untimely death at just 44 years of age of David Knight who suffered a cardiac arrest, David was a generous supporter of the golf day and we will miss his jovial and enthusiastic involvement. To honour his memory there will be a competition during the golf day as well as a significant donation to the British Heart Foundation.

I hope you feel able to join us or help in some other way, whether it is entering a team, sponsoring a hole or donating a prize.

Our auction each year has produced fantastic amounts. If you have or know of, a unique or special experience or item that could be donated for the charity auction please let me know.





OUR CHARITIES FOR 2019

The Rubinstein-Taybi Syndrome Support Group is a registered charity, run on a not-for-profit basis by a management committee of around 12 volunteer trustees. The main aims of the group are to offer support to families and carers of those affected by Rubinstein-Taybi Syndrome (RTS) and to help raise awareness of RTS amongst the medical community and the general population. Money received from the golf day will go to the **CATCH** project to fund home visiting - helping the aged and disabled, many of these have difficulty either travelling to a centre or do not have the mental skills to complete the complicated claim forms.


